2026-27 Player & Family Binding Participation and Membership Agreement for
Sportsmanship and Good Behavior, Team Commitment, Volunteer Obligations,
Facility Safety and Security, and Financial Obligations

Joining a team for the 2026-27 season requires a commitment of time and money from both the family and the club. The player and their family are required to commit to participating in the team for the entire season, adhere to our sportsmanship and conduct standards, and fulfill the specified volunteer and financial responsibilities.

Sportsmanship and Good Behavior

Both our club and leagues (NorCal Premier Soccer, Elite Club National League, National Premier League, and US Club Soccer) understand and value the importance of good sportsmanship and ethical behavior. The result is players who understand the value of civility and respect for others in their relationships on and off the soccer field. Parents must develop a “long-term” view of our wonderful sport that emphasizes developing more skillful players and teams rather than winning games. Coaches and players shall always show maximum respect for the game by always respecting the opposition, the referees, and each other. Parents are also required to consistently show the same respect for the game by offering only positive support for the team. Any behavior outside the bounds of positive encouragement will warrant a club sanction, including but not limited to suspension(s) or expulsion from attending games or from the club.

Parents shall also always show respect to club employees and officials. All types of threats towards club staff or officials, whether veiled or explicit, written, oral, implied, or expressed, and any kind of slander, defamation, false accusation, or other disparaging comment about Davis Legacy Soccer Club or its staff and officials, shall be grounds for immediate dismissal from the club. Being unhappy about your player’s team placement, playing time, or the direction of the team is no excuse for poor sportsmanship and bad behavior.

Finally, at no time shall a parent or player publicly criticize, disparage, call into disrepute, or otherwise defame or slander the club, including any current employee, contractor, official, or officer, in any manner that would reasonably be expected to damage the business, reputation, or services of the club, or our officers, directors, employees, or other representatives. Any such actions shall be grounds for immediate dismissal from the club.

Anyone dismissed from the club due to poor sportsmanship or bad behavior shall no longer be considered in “good standing” and shall be ineligible to participate in any future club activities, including future tryouts, camps, or other programs.

Volunteer Obligations

During the 2026-27 season, our club will host six (6) Davis Legacy Tournaments. Hosting tournaments is a major source of revenue for the club's operations, which directly affects the level of club dues set each year.

Therefore, to maximize our return from each tournament, each family is required to provide three (3) volunteer shifts per registered player at one of our six (6) club-hosted tournaments. During a tournament weekend, all parents of the assigned team can expect to be at the fields for a good portion of the day and to help with pre-tournament assignments during the week(s) leading up to the tournament. If a family is unable to volunteer at their team's assigned tournament, you may request to be rescheduled to volunteer at a future tournament, assuming there is a need for additional volunteer help at a future tournament. Rescheduling is done at the sole discretion of Davis Legacy and is not guaranteed.

For the 2026-27 season, a \$150 volunteer fee will be charged to all competitive team registrations. Families that fulfill their three (3) volunteer shifts will be eligible to have their \$150 volunteer fee refunded. To be eligible for the refund, the family must 1) fulfill their Volunteer Obligations, as outlined in this section, 2) fulfill their Team Commitment, as outlined in the next section, and 3) have no late monthly payments. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Families may elect to forgo fulfilling their volunteer hours. That simply means their volunteer fee will not be refunded. All authorized refunds under this section will take place on or after May 15, 2027.

Team Commitment

Forming a team takes significant time and effort from the club's administrative and coaching staff. Forming a team also requires a substantial upfront funding commitment from the Davis Legacy Soccer Club to operate the team for a full season. As such, each family that receives an offer to join and accepts a position on a club team is expected to participate in that team for the full-prescribed program length. Any family that receives an offer to join and accepts a position on a team at any point after the start of the season is expected to participate in that team for the remainder of the prescribed season. The only exception to this requirement is for players who are no longer in high school and will attend college after the end of summer (applicable only to U18/U19 teams). Only in those specific cases will partial participation and team commitment be allowed.

Facility Safety and Security

Each family that joins for the 2026-27 season will be charged a one-time \$25 Safety and Security Fee to support the management and maintenance of a flock camera system at the two main ingress and egress points to the Davis Legacy Soccer Complex and two Pan-Tilt-Zoom cameras within the internal part of the Davis Legacy Soccer Complex. Families are reminded that you park at your own risk, and that at no time should you leave valuables in your vehicle or leave your doors unlocked. Davis Legacy Soccer Club is not responsible for damage to your vehicle or theft of or from your vehicle. Finally, each family, player, and guest visiting the Davis Legacy Soccer Complex must always follow the facility rules. The

Financial Obligations

Each family with a player participating in a team must pay a one-time Registration Fee of \$200 at the time of registration. This is in addition to the one-time \$150 Volunteer Fee and \$25 Safety and Security Fee described in the previous sections. After these initial one-time payments, each family will be responsible for paying their Club tuition, including the Video Services Fee (if applicable) and the Uniform Kit Fee, over eleven (11) monthly payments as outlined in Appendix A and described further below:

- Video Services Fee—For the 2026-27 season, all U16 to U19 black team participants and all ECNL and ECNL-RL team participants must pay a \$110 Video Services Fee associated with the procurement, maintenance, and annual subscription of VEO video services for their team's use throughout the season. This fee, totaling \$10 per month, will be added to your monthly tuition payments.
- Uniform Kit Fee—For the 2026-27 season, the Uniform Kit fee will be \$462. This fee, totaling \$42 per month, will be added to your monthly tuition payments. All players will receive a home and an away jersey, two pairs of shorts, two pairs of socks, and a jacket. All uniforms will be outfitted with numbers and the club logo, and ECNL or ECNL-RL patches, if applicable to your team. The 2026-27 season is the first year of a new two-year uniform cycle. Members who elect to return for the 2027-28 season will not have to pay this fee in the following season.

The one-time registration fees and the Club tuition help to partially cover various club costs including, but not limited to, coaching (employee) costs, member clinics (striker/skills/keeper), NorCal and ECNL league fees, team tournament entrance fees, NorCal State Cup entrance fees, coach travel reimbursements, US Club registrations, field and facility maintenance, utilities, player and facility insurance, referee fees, etc. ***Please note that club tuition is not set to cover all the costs the club incurs resulting from each team's formation and participation in the 2026-27 season. Other club revenue sources subsidize the cost of operating a team.***

Additionally, the Club tuition does not cover costs associated with individual equipment needs or travel to and from a tournament or league match. There could be other discretionary team-related costs that may materialize, which are also not accounted for in the club tuition, and for which you would be responsible for your fair share of that team's expenses. For ECNL Teams, there are also mandatory travel fees, separate from your club tuition, that each player must pay to participate in the ECNL program. Club tuition is not optional. This is not like a monthly gym membership that you can just stop at any time. No refunds are due if you cannot attend a tournament or training session for any reason, including illness or injury. Refunds are also not provided in the case of field closures due to weather, including, but not limited to, excessive heat or rain, or other dangerous playing conditions that may arise (e.g., poor air quality). Refunds are also not provided due to events outside of the club's control, including, but not limited to, earthquakes, floods, fire, pandemics, etc.

Players who suffer serious injuries lasting more than two months, where such an injury occurred during an approved Davis Legacy activity, may submit a request to the Davis Legacy Soccer Club

seeking a waiver of a portion of the Club's tuition in accordance with the Club's Injured Player Relief Policy. The Club's Injured Player Relief Policy and procedures for submitting a request can be found on the club's website at: [Injured Player Relief Program](#)

The Club provides financial aid ranging from \$650 to \$1,450 for families in financial need. The financial aid does not cover the full amount of the Club's tuition. Interested families will be asked to complete a brief application to confirm financial need and provide supporting documentation. The deadline to submit a Financial Aid application is September 30, 2026. Anyone joining after September 30, 2026, and who receives a Financial Aid award will have their award prorated in a manner determined solely by the Club. Individual teams may provide additional assistance to financial aid families by fundraising throughout the year, with proceeds directed to the financial aid families on the team. It is important that you make all required payments on time. The initial \$200 Registration Fee, \$150 Volunteer Fee, and \$25 Safety and Security Fee are due immediately upon registration. **No Exceptions.** All remaining Club tuition is payable by the 15th of each month and must be submitted according to the following monthly payment schedule (***please note the payment schedule has zero correlation to the team's operating schedule and the club reserves the right to change the program requirements/structure at any time***):

- U9-U19 Teams: June 2026 through April 2027 (11 Monthly Payments beginning June 15, 2026, and ending April 15, 2027).

All one-time Registration Fees and Club Tuition must be paid via credit card or ACH. The club no longer accepts payments by check unless you can demonstrate a compelling financial justification that warrants us to continue a pay-by-check option for you. Accepting payments by check is at the sole discretion of the Davis Legacy Soccer Club.

A family may request to make an advance payment(s) towards their monthly Club tuition, including paying in full, by contacting the club Director of Administration and Finance at: jhoward@davislegacysoccer.org

Monthly tuition payments delinquent for more than sixty (60) days after the due date will result in the player's suspension from practices, games, and any other club activities until the player's account is brought current. If a family is unable to meet the payment schedule due to temporary circumstances, please contact the club's Director of Administration and Finance (email address above) to establish a revised payment plan to accommodate the temporary circumstances.

Moreover, a late fee of \$50 will apply to any monthly payment that is over 60 days overdue, unless an alternative payment schedule has been prearranged with the Club. **No Exceptions.** It is each family's responsibility to ensure their credit card payments go through each month. Sixty (60) days is sufficient time to address issues related to a lost, stolen, or replacement card. Finally, if a family does not meet its full financial obligations for the season, notification will be made to the coaching staff, and participation in any club program and tryouts (including with other teams in the club) will be prohibited until the past-due financial obligation is met. **No Exceptions.**

The undersigned family, by registering for the 2026-27 season with the Davis Legacy Soccer Club, agrees to pay the Volunteer Fee, Registration Fee, Safety and Security Fee, and fulfill the monthly Club tuition payment schedule as outlined above and in Appendix A for the entire 2026-27 season, even if the family voluntarily chooses to leave the club early. If circumstances require the family to leave the team before the end of the team’s 2026-27 season, the family may petition the club Director of Administration and Finance for a waiver from some portion of the remaining cost. However, there is no guarantee that a waiver of any unpaid tuition will be provided. Any approved waiver cannot include the unpaid balances from the Uniform Kit Fee or the Video Services Fee, if applicable. The remaining portion of those fees, which were tacked on and spread out over the 11 monthly payments, will become immediately due and payable prior to release. ***Waivers of any portion of a family’s financial commitment are granted at the sole discretion of the Davis Legacy Soccer Club.***

In addition, all players electing to leave the club early for any reason are subject to an automatic Withdrawal Fee equivalent to two (2) times the player’s monthly tuition. The withdrawal fee covers the club’s costs associated with disenrolling the player from the program and ensures partial club reimbursement for fronting team-related costs incurred due to the player’s participation in the team that has yet to be paid by the player through their monthly tuition payments. As stated above, forming a team is a commitment of both time and money, and the club covers most of the costs once teams are formed. As such, the only way for the club to be reimbursed for covering those costs in advance is through team members’ monthly tuition.

We/I further acknowledge that this is a legally binding agreement to make payments to Davis Legacy Soccer Club for the duration of the 2026-27 season and that Davis Legacy Soccer Club has the legal right to collect on any outstanding payments utilizing any available legal means at the end of the prescribed season should any amounts go unpaid.

We/I further acknowledge that I am eighteen (18) years of age or older and We/I can legally enter into this binding agreement.

Program Details

¹ Club tuition is set at a level to help the club, among other things, cover portions of various costs associated with coaching expenses, club member training clinics, keeper training, field and facility maintenance costs, Insurance, US Club registrations, referee expenses, tournament registration expenses, league registration expenses, coach travel reimbursements, and all other operational costs. ECNL players will also incur specific travel fees not listed above, which are required to participate in that program. ECNL Teams must travel together for all ECNL away events when the club arranges it. Club tuition is in no way intended, nor do they actually cover, all club costs associated with all club activities. They only cover a portion of such costs.

² Teams/Members will/may incur other costs that are specific to their individual team, or the individual member, and are not covered by club tuition. They could/will include: Team Equipment, personal cost of travel, and other team specific discretionary costs, team field rentals, etc.

³ All U9 to U19 Teams may participate in one or two league seasons (Fall 2026 and/or Spring 2027). ECNL Red Teams may only participate in their respective leagues. ECNL may participate in NPL if the club Executive and Technical Directors decide it is in the best interest of team development. There is no guarantee that a team will participate in more than one league season.

⁴ All U15 to U19 teams must take the high school soccer season off, **no exceptions**. This is the club scheduled winter break for these teams.

⁵ All Red/White/Black Teams may participate in no more than 5 tournaments (for all ECNL and Pre-ECNL Teams, and ECRL White Teams, ECNL and/or ECRL Showcases Count as Tournaments). Exceptions to these requirements may be allowed only for Teams that advance to National level competitions by qualifying through league results.

U9 to U12 Red/White/Black Teams may not participate in out-of-state (CAN) tournaments.
 U13 to U14 White/Black Teams may only participate in one out-of-state (CAN) tournament.
 U13 to U14 Red Teams and U15 to U19 White/Black teams may not participate in more than 2 out-of-state (CAN) tournaments.
 U15 to U19 Red Teams may not participate in more than 3 out-of-state (CAN) tournaments.

Please note that the number of tournaments listed is not a requirement; rather, it is a cap. Teams can, and some will do less than the cap, as league games could result in more than enough games for proper team development. The club will be prescribing the majority of tournaments for all teams. For any tournament not prescribed by the club, the decision on the tournament(s) the team will attend is left to the coach to decide, however, the coach's decision is subject to the approval of the Executive Director of Coaching and/or the Technical Director of Coaching **and** the Club Director of Administration and Finance. Participation in tournaments is not guaranteed, and refunds are not provided should a team not participate in a tournament.

⁶ All teams, except ECNL teams, which include ECNL-RL teams when they participate in an ECNL-RL league, may participate in the state cup.

⁷ All Players Pay June 2026 through April 2027 (11 Months). The Season is 12 Months (June 2026 through May 2027), of which 9 months (U15 to U19), or 10 months (U9 to U14) are active, and 12 weeks (U15 to U19) or 8 weeks (U9 to U14) of downtime (rest) is required to be taken. Generally, the off time is taken during the high school or winter season for most teams. **Fees are not waived if you leave the club of your own volition before the end of the season.** Additionally, the monthly tuition is not tied to whether the team is on break or actively training. Spreading the tuition payments over multiple months is merely for the members' convenience.

⁸ U15 to U19 Red/White/Black Team players who are not participating in high school soccer during the winter break may participate in free club training sessions that will be offered by the club during this time period. These sessions are not guaranteed and are subject to field availability during the winter months.

⁹ Soccer is an outdoor activity that can be impacted by inclement weather. Heavy rains can and do close the fields. There are no refunds if games or trainings are canceled as a result of inclement weather, including rain. Closure of the fields is done so at the sole discretion of the club.

¹⁰ Under no circumstances does the Club provide refunds to members as the result of events outside of our control. This includes but is not limited to natural disasters, emergency government actions impacting operations (i.e. pandemics, etc.).

¹¹ A one-time registration fee for the 2026-27 season, totaling \$200, is due immediately upon registration. There is also a one-time volunteer fee of \$150 assessed at the beginning of the season, which will be refunded to the payee at the end of the season if the club's required volunteer requirements are fulfilled, as specified, the payee has no late payments, and the registered player participates for the entire 2026-27 season. Finally, there is a \$110 Video Services Fee per player for all U16, U17, and U19 Black teams, ECNL and ECNL-RL teams, and a one-time \$25 Safety and Security Fee for all players. The Video Services Fee is for the procurement, operation, and maintenance of VEO cameras and associated software subscriptions for each team. The Safety and security Fee is for the procurement, maintenance, and subscription of security PTZ cameras and license plate scanner technology.
